- ❑ Polish Development Bank established in 1924;
- ❑ Head office in Warsaw, 16 regional across Poland, offices in Belgium, Germany and Ukraine;
- ❑ Total assets of PLN 291 bilion as of 31 December 2025;
- ❑ Mission: support to sustainable socio-economic development of Poland (sectors e.g.: Innovation, Infrastructure, Defence, Affordable Housing, Competitive and zero-carbon future)
- ❑ The pillar-assessment accreditation by the EC passed in December 2020;
- ❑ Cooperates with business, public sector and financial institutions, responds to economic needs and undertakes initiatives promoting sustainable development
- ❑ Development cooperation within the Ukraine Facility – support for private sector: investments in energy, logistics and building materials sectors (loans); support for SMEs (loans, investment grants), suport for public sector – municipalities.

- ☐ investment grants implemented by BGK (from 10 to 50% of investment cost, max. **5 mEUR**)

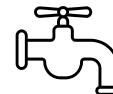
TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
