Over 50,000 people participated in discussions on inclusiveness, diversity, and accessibility.

3 December 2020

The President of Ukraine issued a decree to develop the National Strategy for Creating a Barrier-Free Environment in Ukraine. More than 200 experts and 50 civil society organizations contributed to developing the Barrier-Free Society Strategy.

21 April 2021

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine approved the National Strategy for Creating a Barrier-Free Environment in Ukraine by 2030.




Goal of the Barrier-Free Society Strategy
