We see investment opportunities in two key areas


1. Developing "Cargoto-Post" capacities for Chinese ecommerce


Investment in Ukrposhta logistics and sorting capacities at KBP is needed

Logistics network transformation: as-is network is fragmented and not future-proof

Current complex multi-tiered network of >120 logistics facilities is historically linked to country's administrative division vs. actual volume distribution




- Links to railway connections vs. currently used roadfreight as the only transport mode
- Sub-optimal locations within city limits (e.g., in congested areas next to main railway terminals)
- Process duplication due to multitiered sorting
- Route network overloads central hub in Kyiv (60% of volumes)
- Not tailored towards supporting Retail business of UKRPOSHTA




Logistics network development: USD 50M investment required in the next 3 years

We aim to streamline logistics operations to shift from setup with unreliable transit times to day-definite offering with several service levels







We are now launching a network modeling project with the support of the European Investment Bank to define number, locations and size of future logistics centers and to calculate the full investment case
