- Long term international partnership with the largest railway companies




#### **ELECTRIC LOCOMOTIVES**

- 85 DC electric locomotives


# Ukraine – alternative transit route between EU and Central Asia, China and India and a trading partner of EU with increasing volumes of trade



## Volumes of trade between Ukraine and EU are booming

#### **Possible implementation mechanisms**

- Joint venture where participation of UZ is in the form of land plot contribution
- Long term (50 years) concession of land plot for construction of the terminal




## KEY TAKE AWAY

- **KOVEL** the main alternative to the crossing Brest-Malashevichi on the Belarus-Poland border. From Dostik (border of Kazakhstan and China) to Kovel: 5427 km, to Brest: 5221 km.
- CHOP one of the key Western crossings that allows transportation to Slovakia and Hungary.
- The possibility to provide full service from Ukraine to the final destination point
- Lack of sufficient proposition of comprehensive services on this section of the route from Ukraine to EU.
- Significant cargo transportation volume between EU and Ukraine (bulk cargo as well as cargo in containers)
- 64,4 km of the European width track from the border with Poland to Kovel.


